BARIATRIC

- Gastric banding/removal
- Gastric bypass
- Gastric sleeve



CARDIAC/VASCULAR

- Balloon angioplasty (PTCA)
- Coronary artery bypass graft (CABG)
- Defibrillator implant
- Pacemaker implant/replacement (permanent)
- Stent placement
- Valve repair/replacement
- Varicose vein treatments



GENERAL SURGERY

- Cholecystectomy
- Gallbladder removal
- Hernia repair
- Lithotripsy
- Nissen fundoplication
- Pancreatectomy with duodenectomy (Whipple Procedure)
- Parathyroid exploration
- Thyroid lesion removal
- Thyroidectomy



ORTHOPEDIC

Ankle/Foot

- Achilles tendon repair
- Ankle fusion
- Ankle repair/replacement
- Arthroscopy
- Hammer toe repair
- Plantar fascia release

Hand/Wrist/Elbow

- Carpal tunnel release
- Elbow fusion/replacement
- Ganglion cyst removal
- Palmer fasciectomy
- Trigger finger release
- Wrist fusion/replacement

Hip

- Arthroscopy
- Hip replacement/revision

Knee

- ACL/MCL/PCL repair
- Arthroscopy
- Knee replacement/revision

Shoulder

- Arthroplasty (joint replacement)
- Arthroscopy
- Bicep tendon repair
- Rotator cuff repair
- Shoulder repair



SPINE/NEUROLOGICAL

- 360 spinal fusion
- Anterior/posterior cervical fusion (ACDF, PCF)
- Anterior/posterior/extreme lumbar interbody fusion (ALIF, PLIF, XLIF)
- Artificial disc replacement
- Decompression/laminectomy
- Deep brain stimulation
- Discectomy/microdiscectomy
- Spinal cord stimulator
- Tarlov cyst removal



WOMEN'S HEALTH

- Bladder prolapse repair
- Breast reconstruction
- Hysterectomy
- Lysis of adhesions
- Pelvic support procedure
